CIBER WINS SEAT AT IN-FLIGHT TABLE WITH GATE GOURMET
CIBER To Provide IT Outsourcing, Development Services To Airline Caterer

RESTON, Va. – Jan. 23, 2006 – CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) today announced it has been chosen by Gate Gourmet, the world’s largest independent supplier of airline catering, based in Reston, Va. and Zurich, Switzerland, to provide technical, help desk, and application development and management support to the firm’s U.S.-based employees. CIBER will perform the work from its Edison, N.J., and Memphis, Tenn., facilities. The projects are forecast to reduce IT costs for Gate Gourmet’s Americas Division by nearly 40 percent over the length of the two-year contract.

Under the terms of the contract, CIBER’s IT Operations service desk in Edison, N.J.—one of CIBER’s outsourcing centers called CIBERsites—will provide technical and help desk support to Gate Gourmet’s 5,000 U.S. employees. This support includes receiving, recording, and resolving trouble calls via phone, fax, or e-mail 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. CIBER is also responsible for tracking and resolving routine issues—such as password resets and remote control of desktop computers—to resolving or escalating more serious issues to Gate Gourmet’s onsite desk-side support, as required. Administration of Gate Gourmet’s automatic call distribution service will be transferred to CIBER as well. Call volume is predicted to be approximately 1,000 calls per month.

From its Memphis facility, CIBER will manage all aspects of Gate Gourmet’s U.S.-based legacy software application development and management process, including development, support, and upgrades, culminating in the phase-out of obsolete programs.

As a result of the projects, Gate Gourmet will reduce IT costs and standardize and streamline business processes, resulting in greater efficiency and flexibility in meeting changing client needs.

“CIBER’s ability to provide subject matter expertise, flexibility, and a true partner relationship at reasonable costs with little or no effect on delivery was too valuable to pass up,” said Jim Robins, Divisional Information Officer for Gate Gourmet Americas. “As a first step toward enhancing our business, having a centralized solution was a very important and strategic factor in the selection process.”
