Based in the county seat of Lawrenceville, the Gwinnett County Solicitor General's office employs 17 attorneys and 6 investigators, and the District Attorney's office employs 36 attorneys and 23 investigators in its three divisions: Trial Division, Criminal Investigation Division, and Victim-Witness Unit. The offices have been using several older software applications to maintain the data needed to investigate crimes, prosecute offenders, and serve the needs of crime victims and witnesses. However, these applications did not offer critical features needed to manage large caseloads, thus requiring significant staff time for tedious and routine tasks, and taking time away from the more critical tasks of investigating and preparing cases.

In addition, there was no central method of tracking case progress, so deadlines and critical dates could be easily overlooked.

To address these challenges, CIBER will implement and deploy its Web-based SecureLaw™ CRIMES (Case Records Information Management and Exchange System) product, and assist with knowledge transfer. The SecureLaw™ CRIMES solution will provide Gwinnett County with a standard database and a customizable user interface that can be quickly and easily tailored to meet the County's specific needs and preferences.
