CIBER WINS \$1.7 MILLION CONTRACT WITH USDA RISK MANAGEMENT AGENCY To Provide Independent Validation and Verification of Agency's IT Infrastructure Initiative

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Sep. 6, 2006 – CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) has won a \$1.7 million contract to provide independent validation and verification (IV&V) services to the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Risk Management Agency (RMA).

The RMA is responsible for developing and maintaining crop insurance programs sold through private insurance companies to farmers throughout the United States. The agency is embarking on a major re-engineering of its entire information technology (IT) infrastructure to take advantage of new technology developments that can help streamline its insurance operations, improve information security, eliminate redundant effort, reduce costs, and enhance customer service.

During the project, CIBER will provide on-going review and analysis of the RMA's re-engineering program, presenting recommendations for process and technological improvements to the agency's Chief Information Officer.

CIBER has completed other work for the USDA, most recently providing software development, maintenance, and support services for the Farm Services Agency, to help that organization modernize its IT systems, centralize loan servicing functions, and reduce support costs.

"Over the years, we've built a solid relationship and a reputation for strong performance with USDA through our application development and management services," said Wally Birdseye, President of CIBER's Federal Government Solutions Division. "We're pleased to be able to build on that for USDA's Risk Management Agency, and, given our direct reporting relationship with the Agency's CIO, we're honored by the trust and responsibility they've shown us."

The RMA manages the operations of the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation, which was founded in 1938. The RMA employs 530 people in offices nationwide. It provides 1.19 million insurance policies to farmers throughout the U.S., insuring 246 million acres of farmland and managing more than \$44 billion worth of insurance liabilities.
