**CIBER GAINS NASHVILLE ELECTRIC SERVICE EXTENSION**  
**\$5 Million Dollar Win Continues IT Services to Major Utility**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – July 16, 2007 – CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) has won a \$5 million contract extension to provide IT outsourcing services to Nashville Electric Service (NES), one of the 11 largest public utilities in the U.S. which delivers energy to approximately 350,000 customers in middle Tennessee. The multi-million dollar win is an extension of CIBER’s three-year IT outsourcing engagement with NES, which CIBER began in October 2004. The total value of the contract to date – including the newly won extension – is \$18 million.
