CIBER MOTOR VEHICLE PROJECT WINS 2007 ACHIEVEMENT AWARD FROM NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY GOVERNMENTS

FORT WORTH, Texas – Aug. 2, 2007 – A Motor Vehicle Inventory Tracking System developed by CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) for the Tarrant County, Texas, Tax Office has won the National Association of Counties' (NACo) 2007 Achievement Award.

The annual NACo Achievement Award is a non-competitive award program that provides national recognition to county accomplishments, seeking to honor innovative county government programs that modernize and streamline business processes and increase services to citizens.

CIBER designed, built, implemented, and integrated the motor vehicle inventory application, called MVITS, to help the county efficiently manage the 1.6 million vehicle registrations and 500,000 title transfers it processes each year. CIBER built MVITS using Microsoft .NET technology. MVITS is a solution that can be easily implemented at other large county Tax Assessor offices seeking an efficient, cost-effective vehicle tracking system.

MVITS was built in two phases. The original version of the application was built and implemented in 2005. It won the County Best Practices Award from the Texas Association of Counties at that time.

The newest release of MVITS—and the version that won the 2007 NACo Achievement Award—incorporates more powerful and detailed inventory tracking features to help the county monitor its inventory of license plates, windshield stickers, and transfer forms, which are provided to dealers to register and title vehicles as bonded agents of the tax office.

The new version of MVITS also offers self-service Web features, so auto dealers can update their profile, review bond status, and order inventory online, thus reducing the number of trips to the Tax Assessor's Office to complete routine registration transactions. In addition, the new version tracks title rejections and links to the County's document management system so that documents such as bonds and other customer documents can be reviewed online. This online capability makes vital information accessible and allows for safe storage of the original document.

The MVITS system has reduced the time to maintain dealer inventory by more than 50% for annual savings of \$25,000 and has identified more than one million dollars in changes to dealer bonds to avoid potential losses in case of dealer financial hardship.

“We’re very pleased with CIBER’s technical leadership on this project,” said Tarrant County Tax Assessor-Collector Betsy Price. “The new system has truly transformed our operations by enhancing customer service, enabling more efficient management of employees’ time, reducing the risk associated with dealer bonds, and providing real-time inventory and bond value status.”

Prior to CIBER’s MVITS application, Tarrant County used a mostly manual system to track inventory. This system required more than 200 hours per month of labor and did not provide an up-to-date picture of inventory. Inaccurate inventory subjected the tax office to significant potential financial loss if a dealer experienced economic hardship.

Tarrant County has more than 1.5 million residents—many of whom live in Fort Worth, the county’s largest city. This represents roughly seven percent of Texas’ 22 million residents, and covers 864 square miles.
