**CIBER WINS \$6.5 MILLION SOCIAL SERVICE CASE MANAGEMENT PROJECT  
Will Build Automated Case Management and Eligibility System (ACES) for Clark County, Nev.**

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA – Oct. 15, 2007 – CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) has won a \$6.5 million contract to implement a case management system for the Clark County, Nev., Department of Social Service (CCSS). The multi-year project will replace the County’s existing case management system with one that will allow timely access to accurate, complete, and current case and payment information critical to CCSS’s fulfillment of its public responsibilities.

CIBER’s implementation of the Automated Case Management and Eligibility System, or ACES, is expected to improve worker productivity; streamline service delivery; eliminate redundant data entry; retire manual, paper-based processes; validate and accurately reconcile financial information with the County’s financial system; and share information with CCSS partner organizations to track client referrals, progress, and outcomes.

“Clark County is looking forward to working with CIBER to improve the delivery of services to needy and vulnerable residents,” said Nancy McLane, Director of Clark County Social Service.

For ACES, CIBER will provide services spanning all project phases, including project planning, requirements definition, system design and configuration, data conversion, interface and report development, testing, and training.

The ACES technology is based on the Cúram Business Application Suite, and encompasses critical functional areas, including intake, eligibility, client management, and financial management. The Cúram Business Application Suite, based on the Cúram Enterprise Framework™, combines the advantages of commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) software, an enterprise platform, and service-oriented architecture with the business and technical flexibility required to allow agencies to implement solutions to meet their strategic objectives.
