**CIBER COMPLETES PHASE I GO LIVE FOR OMNITRANS
AND CONTRACTS FOR \$6 MILLION PHASE II PROJECT**

SAN BERNADINO COUNTY, Calif. – Aug 11, 2009 - CIBER, Inc. (NYSE: CBR) a global provider of information technology (IT) services, went live in July with implementations of several SAP® applications for San Bernardino's largest transportation agency, Omnitrans.
